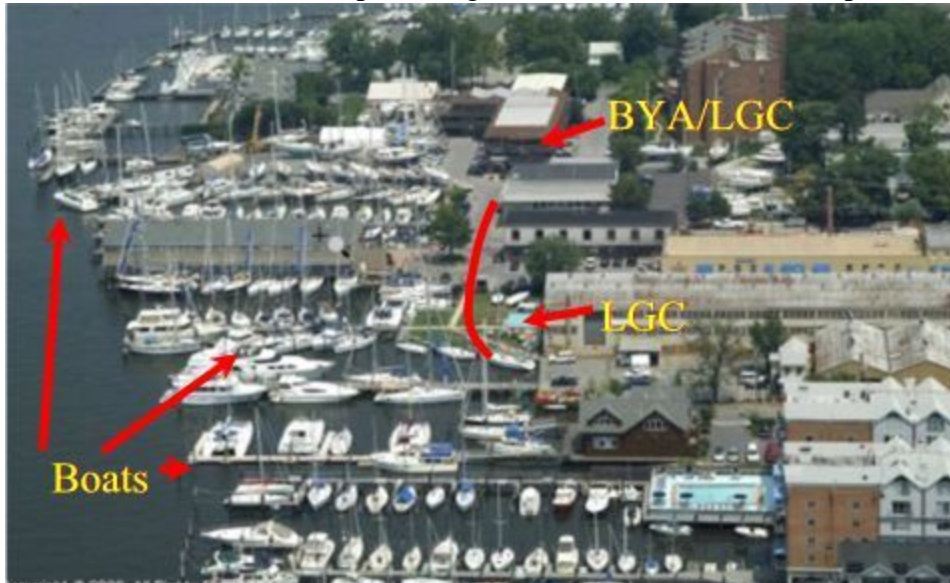

Here are some helpful things to do and see around Annapolis.

(F) Ruth Chris Steak House (two blocks from our office).410-990-0033 **(E)** Lewnes steak house "The one restaurant to visit before you die!" 410-263-1617 (3 blocks from our office.) Across from **(D)** Carols Creek Restaurant. 410-263-8102 Best waterfront dining, just great. Best Sailors pub in Eastport, **(D)** The BoatYard Bar and Grill across from Carols Creek 410-216-6206

- Davis pub--for crab cakes! end of 4th st. bottom of screen not marked--it's our secret place!

- Near but not in Annapolis. Charming, romantic (Be sure to try an after dinner port!--stay late, very late (Kent Manor Inn on Kent Island 410 643-5757): Kentmorr for sunset dining, Crabs Across Bay Bridge (410) 643-2263

- HARBOR MOORINGS. Try to pick one in the middle of the group away from the channels. BEST ANCHORAGE. N.E. of this point. (Sarles Marina). **(T)** Better holding and protection--quieter. The water taxi will still come and pick you up.

- BEST YACHT CLUB. Annapolis Yacht Club **(G)** Worth a visit if you're a member of another club. Great food.

Beautiful facilities. One of the oldest in the Country. (410) 263-9279 However the famous Eastport Yacht Club

(L) across from our office on First St. could be the best informal, active club, and then there's the famous, Severn Sailing Association next to that, and...

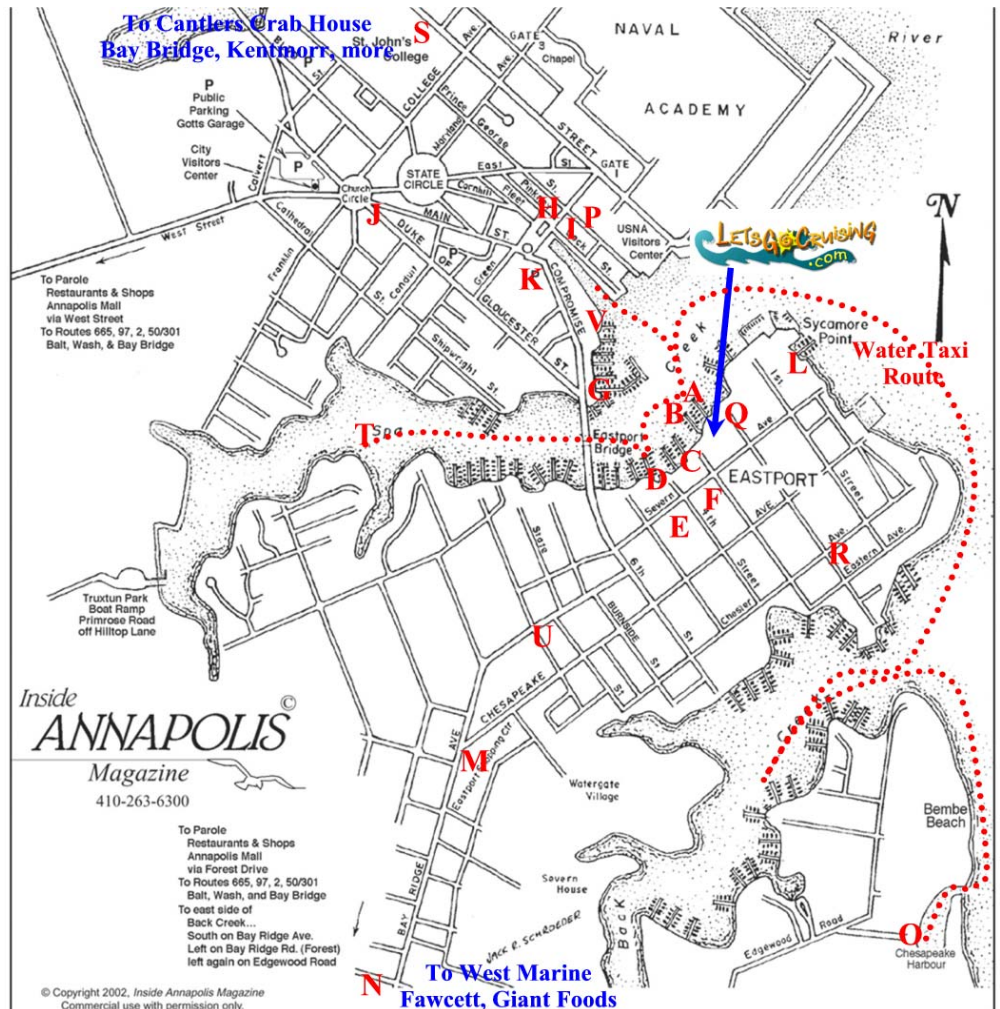


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- Fawcett's. BEST MARINE CHANDLERY (N) (Moved now on Bay Ridge) Loaded with gear, and knowledgeable staff. (There is also a West Marine about 2 mi. drive West on Chesapeake Ave. (At Bay Ridge/Forest-- Chesapeake changes name to Bay Ridge.) (N)
- Pussers landing restaurant. (V) Sailors pub. Sailors fare. On the harbor--actually, "Ego Alley" Watch the parade of boats showing off.
- FOOD AND LIQUOR FOR PROVISIONING-Eastport Plaza Liquor. (M) Just off the map, West on Chesapeake Ave. at a small shopping center. Or, Bar Ridge Liquors 1.5 miles up Bay Ridge Ave at BlockBuster shopping center (Also home of West Marine) (N)
- MAJOR GROCERY: At Bay Ridge Plaza about 2 miles-"Giant". Up Chesapeake to Bay Ridge, left on Forest (Changes name to Bay Ridge) to first traffic light, left into Forest Plaza--Large Giant Food store. (N)
- BEST WINE/LIQUOR STORE. Mills. (K) On the small main street circle near the city dock. (Also, Eastport Liquors, Bay Ridge and now, Boatyard bar and Grill (D) --ask us for directions. All near by.)
- NICE, HISTORIC RESTAURANT. Middletons (H) on the Harbor square (410) 263-3323. Evening folk music most nights, the center of a large group of bars. Marias-Italian, (410) 268-2112 next to McGarveys--both have valet parking..
- BEST, E. COAST SAILORS PUB. McGarveys. (410) 263-5700 (H) A real pub with great pub food. You'll see the likes of Walter Cronkite, Gary Jobson or any other sailing celebrity in town here. The place to be seen and to meet
- Best Italian (Sicilian)--Marias! (H) Meet Maria, ask for Bob.. (410) 268-2112
- MOST ROMANTIC RESTAURANT. King of France Tavern--Maryland Inn (410) 263-2641 (J). A historic rendezvous with all the right ingredients including live Jazz for a romantic evening. Also, out of the way, and by boat if you know the way--Sams-(O) --on the water (410) 793-4383

- ANTIQUE SHOPPING AND STROLLING . Maryland Ave. (S) Lots of shops. Don't forget this lovely section of Annapolis if you're strolling around.
- MOST INTERESTING (Popular-over 1M visitors/year!) TOUR. The Naval Academy. (P) Go in the gate off Randall Street (Near {I}) . Very interesting and they offer a great guided tour. for great information. 410-263-1000
- Most unusual tour--try a Segway(P). 800-250-1550
- Kayak rental in Annapolis--in the middle of our marina.
- Undiscovered restaurant? Wild Orchid. (U) You can walk a little further. (410) 268-8009 Longish walk
